Dear Henning,

WHAT WAS ORDERED: Obtain minutes for all CCHI meetings from its inception to present time (there are two meetings each year - May and November.

WHAT WAS DONE: The CCHI meeting minutes were found on file with the AMA, and all AMA files on CCHI were obtained. We have all minutes except for the year 1966, and this year was missing from the AMA files. Only two sets of minutes are kept - one at the AMA and one at the National Health Council. As we haven't the resources in New York at this time to obtain or search for the 1966 minutes at the National Health Council, Legal Branch 2 was consulted as to whether or not we have sufficient evidence to proceed with the suit without the 1966 records. Branch 2 Legal Dir has attested that we do. Hence this target is being reported as done.

This is OK.

CONSPIRACY SUIT DE-FUD PROJECT

MAJOR TARGET

To get documentation (letters, witnesses, etc.) to show a harmful act done as result of CCHI conspiracy. "As result" means we've got to be able to link the harmful act back to CCHI, and document it with letters, witnesses, etc., to show it could not be coincidence.

VITAL TARGET: RL to maintain liaison with Legal Bureau - ask us hypothetical questions or whatever - to ensure no time wasted in obtaining product not usable by Legal or useful to RL.

OPERATING TARGETS

1. Obtain minutes for all CCSI meetings from its inception to PT (there are 2 meetings each year - May & November): 1963 COLLOFF Info

2. Review actual minutes mentions of Scientology and note in what context or in regards to which agency Scientology is mentioned. CIC OFF Info

3. With each mention, date-coordinate attacks from this agency (or attacks which can be traced to this agency). CIC OFF Info

4. With each instance found above, continue to pull the string to find the link between the attack and the CCHI meeting mention and document this link (documentation = letters, notes, witnesses who will testify, etc.). CIC OFF COLLOFF Info

5. Turn data obtained in #4 above over to legal as each string is complete. CIC OFF BLIDA Info

6. Es: entheta articles: Check to see if, after meeting mention of Scientology, there is false data supplied to writers/publishers of entheta by CCHI member(s) agencies. Document (via correspondence, witnesses, etc.) the link. CIC OFF COLLOFF Info

7. Turn data obtained in #5 above over to legal as it is obtained. CIC OFF, COLLOFF, BLIDA Info

Following are examples of useful data and documentation:

1. At CCHI meeting, discussed that there must be a way to get Sen via Post Office. Shortly thereafter, postal permits revoked. (Link = mention and time proximity. Better would be actual written documentation between CCHI member agencies, etc.)

2. At CCHI meeting, discussed to get bad press on Sen. Shortly thereafter, entheta appears based on false reports sent by (and traceable to) CCHI members.

Attest from Paul Klopper Legal US Branch 11 that "we have enough data (CCHI minutes) from BI to proceed with the required suit (conspiracy suit) and it is not vital that we have the missing set of minutes (1966)" (pg 3)

Attest from Judy Taussig BI CIC that all the CCHI minutes except 1966 are on file in 3I US CIC. (pg 4)

Data from CCHI 1972 May meeting shows Scientology discussed with Paulette Cooper mentioned. (pg 5) Data from CCHI meeting May 1973 shows that the AMA added Scientology to the agenda with Doyle Taylor talking about Freedom mag attacking the IRS and that a Dr. Evans of the FDA stated that the E-meter and its material is not to be used for diagnosis or treatment. (pg 9)

CCHI minutes of 1970 show an attack of Laetrile. (pg 11)

CCHI minutes of 1968 (pg 13) show that the FTC said that CCHI members should continue to send questionable books to the FTC. (pg 14,1) A Mr. Shuette from the FDA stated that the gov't won the Sen. E-meter case and mention was made that the IRS recinded LRH tax exempt status. (pg 14,2)
